Why do I need a 1099-G tax form?

- Unemployment insurance benefits are taxable income

What information is on a 1099-G tax form?

- Unemployment benefits paid to you
- Federal and state income taxes withheld from your benefits
- Repayments of overpaid benefits

Where do I get my 1099-G tax form?

- View or print a copy of your current or previous year forms online: <http://my.unemployment.wisconsin.gov>
- Log on using your user name and password, then go to the "Unemployment Services" menu to access your 1099-G tax forms

When can I get my 1099-G tax form?

- Information for the most recent tax year will be available online mid-January
